Student Service Guidelines

- Students are required to complete 15 hours of service to the school and community each year.
- We limit service done at or for OPS to a maximum of eight hours.
- A single event may not account for more than half of your annual service hours. For example, a week-long mission trip to Peru counts for no more than eight hours of the required 15 annual service hours.
- Community service means a service done in the community. Babysitting does not count unless you are helping a family in need (that is not your own) and you are not getting paid.
- Service performed for your family is not eligible for community service hours.
- If you are paid for the service, you may not include the service in your volunteer services hours.
- We will not accept service hours unless they are signed by the supervisor in charge of your activity.
- You cannot donate any books or supplies in exchange for service hours.
- You may not count carpooling as service hours unless approved by the administration at the beginning of the year or before any carpooling has begun.
